Overall Summary of INOVA Community Health Fund Grant Implementation

The Marie Maxey Foundation implemented the "Heart Program: Increasing Local Capacity for CPR AED Skills" in Fairfax, County. The initiative met grant objectives in promoting activities to cover healthcare access gaps in Lorton and Centreville by establishing sustainable, culturally responsive, local emergency response training capacity.

Overall Outcomes: Over the last twelve months, we have successfully supported three local organizations (South County Church and ICNA Relief in Lorton; and Centreville Immigration Forum in Centreville) to become Red Cross-certified training services providers for Pediatric & Adult First Aid, CPR AED certification. Working with these organizations, we provided training equipment, funded the certification of eight instructors affiliated with them, and trained 116 residents for a two-year Red Cross certification in AED CPR emergency response. In addition, we worked with these local organizations to provide CPR orientation to 464 Fairfax County residents. The result of these efforts is the creation of three local organizations now operating independently and in a sustainable manner to continue providing emergency training to Lorton and Centreville. All three organizations have the credentials, equipment, certified staff, and operational expertise to continue this critical life-saving training.

CPR Orientation – Explanation of how CPR works and then having the person perform a CPR cycle (30 compressions and 2 breaths). For each person that could perform a CPR cycle they received a free key chain with a face shield for giving breaths – 464 residents did this and received a key chain.

- **Instructor Training:** As these local entities began conducting Red Cross CPR AED classes, they all saw a need for additional instructors. The Foundation provided instructor certification for eight volunteer staff (3 for Centreville Immigration Forum, 3 for South County Church, and 2 for ICNA Relief). Each of these instructors is qualified to teach Pediatric & Adult First Aid CPR AED to county residents and to certify residents that complete the training.
- **Equipment Distribution:** Full sets of professional training equipment—including Prestan adult manikins with feedback, AED trainers, and accessories—have been provided to each of the three active organizations. With the amendment of the grant agreement to focus on three local entities instead of the five that were originally planned, the amount of funding dedicated to each entity went up. The Centreville Immigration Forum received a total of \$2,100 in equipment while ICNA Relief received \$2,300. South County Church received \$4,435 in training equipment and, at their request, a functioning AED.
- **Certification and Capacity Building:** Each of these three entities is officially recognized as a Red Cross Training Services Provider and have signed training contracts with the Red Cross, conducted 29 CPR AED classes under their contract and registered 116 participants for two-year CPR AED certificates from the Red Cross. Fairfax County now has three dynamic local entities in providing training and outreach aimed at increasing emergency response and saving lives.

- **Community Outreach and Training:** The program has accomplished 464 non-certified CPR orientations. Furthermore, a total of 116 Adult CPR AED certifications were accomplished, and all 108 scholarships were utilized with these local partners starting to hold their on training classes without support from our program.
- **Financial Standing:** Total expenditures for the grant period (August 1, 2025 – July 31, 2026) are \$23,213. Our foundation covered costs that exceeded the \$21,500 total budget of our grant.

Unanticipated Issues:

The level of effort required to help each organization become Red Cross certified as a training services provider and to initiate CPR AED classes was more complicated than originally contemplated. Our foundation requested an amendment to our grant from CHS to allow us to work with three local organizations instead of with five. This request was approved and the grant budget was amended to reflect the change. As we began implementation of training programs, the local organizations saw a need to have more than one instructor. A request was made to increase the number of certified instructors from three to eight. This resulted in a budget overrun in the line item for “Instructor Training.” South County Church in Lorton requested a functioned AED to be used in demonstrating CPR AED response. We complied with their request, and this resulted in our expending \$1,000 more than originally anticipated (we covered these costs out of our own budget). The total grant was \$21,500 and we spent \$23,213 implementing it, expending \$1,713 of our own funding.

Next Steps:

Our foundation will continue to mentor these local organizations as needed. We will continue to conduct Red Cross-certified CPR AED classes at the Lorton Community Action Center and support the outreach activities of South County Church, ICNA Relief, and the Centreville Immigration Forum. We are also encouraging these entities to seek grant funding to continue and expand their life-saving training courses. As well as expand their training portfolio to include babysitting classes, grandparenting classes and other types of emergency response training.

Our foundation board thanks the INOVA Community Health Fund for this support in helping to prepare our community for emergency response.

Purpose of the Grant

The purpose of this grant is to increase access to life-saving **CPR AED training** in underserved areas of Fairfax County, Virginia by establishing in-house training capacity at SCC. Through this initiative, SCC will deliver **Red Cross-certified Adult CPR AED training** to local residents and identify a community member or staff person to become a **Red Cross-certified CPR AED instructor**.

Grant Amount and Use of Funds

The Marie Maxey Foundation will provide a **total grant of up to \$5,000**, allocated as follows:

1. Instructor Certification:

- o \$750 to support Red Cross certification for one instructor affiliated with SCC in Adult CPR AED.

2. Training Equipment (In-Kind Contribution):

- o In-kind equipment grant valued up to \$1,500. Equipment includes CPR manikins, AED trainer units, and accessories.

3. Participant Scholarships:

- o Up to \$2,750 in scholarships for 36 SCC community members to receive a **two-year Red Cross CPR AED certificate**.
- o Each scholarship is valued at \$75:
 - \$32 covers the Red Cross certification fee (paid directly by the Marie Maxey Foundation to the Red Cross),
 - \$43 will be provided to SCC to compensate the SCC instructor for course delivery.

Obligations of SCC (Grantee)

1. Training Sessions:

- o Conduct up to **six (6) CPR AED training classes** between **August 1, 2025 and July 31, 2026**.
- o Each session would enroll at least **six (6) participants**, for a total of **36 trained residents**.

2. Instructor Identification and Certification:

- Designate one church member or local community member to complete the Red Cross CPR AED Instructor Certification, supported by the Foundation.
- 3. **Scholarship Management:**
 - Submit a report after each class to request disbursement of \$75 per certified participant (up to 36 participants).
 - The scholarship covers the \$32 Red Cross fee and \$43 payment to the SCC instructor.
- 4. **Facilities and Community Outreach:**
 - To the extent possible, provide suitable space for all training sessions.
 - Promote CPR AED training opportunities through SCC's communication channels and community outreach efforts.
- 5. **Program Reporting:**
 - Submit a report prior to August 1, 2026, to the Foundation detailing: (1) Number of participants trained, (2) Certification outcomes, (3) Use of funds, and (4) Community impact and feedback.

Obligations of the Marie Maxey Foundation (Grantor)

1. **Funding and Supplies:**
 - Provide up to \$5,000 in total grant support, disbursed as:
 - Up to \$750 for instructor certification (paid directly by the Grantor),
 - Up to \$2,750 in scholarship reimbursements (paid by the Grantor after each training class),
 - Up to \$1,500 in training equipment (delivered in-kind).
2. **Program Support:**
 - Offer technical and programmatic assistance to SCC and its CPR AED instructor throughout the grant period.
